

AID Fellowship Dermatopathology Course 2026

The course is run over two semesters of 14 weeks each semester . It follows on from the DermPath Advanced course and teaches more detail in DermPath correlation. In week 1 of each module in Semester 1 we look through a series of clinical and dermpath cases and discuss the differential diagnoses. There is also a virtual slide discussion of the cases which is recorded. In week 2 of semester 1 we look through various clinical presentations and the corresponding histopath for the likeliest causes of those presentations. Eg scaly scalp or oral lesions , diffuse leg induration etc.

In Semester 2 Week 1 looks at mainly skin tumours including many adnexal tumours and week 2 continues the Clinical Corelation topics.

The books you purchased for the Advanced DermPath course will be useful in the Fellowship course. See below.

You should consider buying 3 books for the course. 1 Christine Ko Dermatology Visual Recognition and Case Reviews. 2 Dermatopathology by Dirk Elston and Dermatopathology Challenge by Barnhill McGraw Hill. Dermatopathology by Elston will be particularly useful in the Fellowship course.

We will access some Virtual Slides for each module.

There is a one hour recorded video each week for each module and a video discussing the Virtual slides . The course is completely online. You will receive emails twice a week detailing what you should be studying. There are no module assessments but there are online live end of semester exams .
